



REOPENING OF THE LAGOON AND SPORTS TAVERN OUTLETS FOR DINE-IN AND THE TENNIS COURTS

In line with the announcement made by the Government on 19th August 2021, the General Committee has approved the opening of the Club's F&B facilities for dine-in effective Saturday, **28th August 2021**, subject to compliance to the SOPs provided.

Only members who are fully vaccinated (as per entry guideline on page 3) will be allowed to the admin office, tennis courts and operating outlets. Unvaccinated family members below 17 years are allowed entry and must be accompanied by the member at all times.

| Sports Tavern : | 44 seats (13 tables) | 4pm - 10pm |

Only members and their family members are allowed until further notice due to the limited seating capacity. **Last call for F&B orders is at 9pm. Members will be required to leave the Club by 10pm at the latest.**

Car Park : 7am - 10pm Daily

Admin Office : 9:30am – 5:30pm Monday to Friday | 9:30am to 1:30pm on Saturday

Tennis Courts : 8am – 8pm pm Daily (Singles game only) – **Operational effective 25th August 2021**

All other sports and recreational facilities and activities will remain closed until further notice.

General Guidelines

1. The Club appreciates the cooperation of all members to comply with the directives set forth by the Majlis Keselamatan Negara (MKN).
2. The Club will display the staff vaccination status (percentage) at the entrance as an update for members.
3. Please check-in at the outlet(s) / facilities patronised in addition to the check-in at the Reception.
4. All persons entering the Club, including vendors/contractors will be subject to the entry policy.
5. Unvaccinated family members below 17 years are allowed to dine-in provided that the accompanying members comply with our entry policy.
6. Any updates on the Club's SOP will be displayed at the Club's main notice board, broadcasted to members via Whatsapp message broadcasting services (017-614 6864) and updated on the Club's website (www.royalklangclub.com.my).
7. Members are encouraged to settle their outstanding balances to the Club to avoid any service interruption. Payment can be made via online banking or JomPay facilities. Due to the present situation, online payment is preferred. Please refer to the latest bulletin for payment details.
8. Indoor activities are not recommended by MKN until further notice.

ENTRY GUIDELINES FOR COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Please update your MySejahtera profile to verify your risk status, show vaccination digital card / certificate, Check temperature & Sanitise your hands before entry



Note :

- Compulsory to use MySejahtera to enter the Club. (No smart phone : Register at the log book)
- * Fully vaccinated (JKJAV):
 - (i) A minimum of 14 days after 2nd dose vaccination - Pfizer, AstraZeneca and Sinovac
 - (ii) A minimum of 28 days after single-dose vaccination - CanSino and Johnson & Johnson
- Maintain distancing of at least 1 meter at all time within the Club premises
- Guest / Affiliated Club members are not allowed entry.
- Unvaccinated family members below 17 years are allowed entry
- Applies to everyone who enters the Club, including vendors and contractors



Not Allowed Entry

- Confirmed Cases Under Home Surveillance Order
- Close Contact
- Person Under Surveillance (PUS)
- Person Under Investigation (PUI)



Allowed

- Low Risk / No Symptom
- Casual Contact / No Symptom
- Fully vaccinated *

F&B Outlets Operation Guidelines

1. The following F&B outlets will be operational:

- a. Lagoon: 100 seats (37 tables)**
- b. Sports Tavern: 44 seats (13 tables)**

The sound of a bell ringing at 9pm will indicate last call for F&B orders.

2. A Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for operating F&B outlets has been provided to all staff and members are requested to be patient and cooperate with the staff on duty. Staff will use the provided sanitisers / hand wash frequently.
3. A limited F&B menu will be available at the operating outlets. No food or drinks service available outside the operating outlets.
- 4. Staff will not be able to provide any form of butler/pouring service to members in line with distancing guidelines.**
- 5. Bottles to be parked at the outlet will be removed from the table for parking at 9:45pm. All members must leave the Club by 10pm at the latest as per MKN directive.**
6. Members are encouraged to contact the Club at 03-33714625 for take-away services. No table reservation allowed. Please call the Club to check on table availability.

Facilities and Activities

1. The tennis courts will be open, subject to the Club's entry policy. Strictly no F&B services at the tent. Please ensure that there are no more than 4 persons at the tennis courts at any time.

2. All other facilities at the Club not stated will remain closed until further notice.
3. **STRICTLY NO usage of shower rooms for changing/bathing purposes as per MKN directive.**
4. All other team / group / contact and indoor sports and their related facilities are not allowed.
5. Booking of sports facilities under Royal Klang Club for activities outside the Club premises are strictly not allowed.
6. Socials, championships or any events / gatherings will not be allowed, including birthday, wedding, anniversary celebrations, etc.

This SOP will be enforced until such time a new guideline is provided by relevant authorities. Any updates to this SOP will be placed at the main notice board at the Lobby, broadcasted to members via WhatsApp broadcasting services and updated on the Club's official website.

Where there is an overlap between this SOP and the Club's existing Rules and Regulations and Bye-Laws, this SOP shall prevail until such time this it is no longer enforced by the State and Federal Governments.

Disciplinary action will be taken against members who are not in compliance with the stated SOPs. All outlets are under CCTV surveillance in accordance to the Club's Bye-Laws.
