#### LAUNCH OF RKC 125th ANNIVERSARY LOGO

Royal Klang Club President Kenny Lee officially launched the unveiling of the RKC 125th Anniversary logo on Saturday, July 19, 2025 at a ceremony held at the Smugglers' Inn. With the theme 'Embracing A New Horizon', the newly unveiled logo reflects the spirit and aspirations of the Club as it continues to grow and evolve as the premier social and recreational institution in Selangor.

Present at the function were several past RKC presidents including Mr Sia Say Yee, Mr R. Nageswaran, Mr Lim Tee Pheow, Dato' Liew Chin Kwee, Dato Ang Ben Kiong and Mr Hotiyakumar Kandasamy. Others included RKC vice-president Serjeet Singh and the chairman of the RKC 125th Anniversary organising committee Mr K. Thavanesan, the newly installed General Committee members as well as the various sports captains and invited guests. Puan Khairoon Kamaruddin, the Club's long serving and retired accounts executive who served under various RKC presidents, was a special guest.

Mr Nageswaran, speaking on behalf of past RKC presidents, congratulated the Club on what he said was a significant milestone for an institution that has evolved into a landmark institution not just in the state but the country too. 




### **MALE SAUNA**
